

Maintenance of Wooden Components

Wood is a natural material that continuously changes, even after processing. The need for maintenance varies depending on how exposed the surfaces are, or have been, to sun, water, and mechanical wear.

We recommend inspecting your furniture products at least twice a year to ensure that any algae growth or dirt is removed. Avoid using high-pressure washers and chemicals that may damage the surface and make it more susceptible to future growth.

Maintenance of Linseed-Oil-Impregnated Pine (Linax)

1. Clean the surface with a mild detergent.
2. Rinse thoroughly.
3. Allow the wood surface to dry.
4. Linseed-oil-impregnated pine will naturally turn grey after a few years. To prevent cracking and extend the product's lifespan, we recommend oiling the wood approximately every three years using, for example, a linseed-based wood oil.
